





Adventure-Time

Whether passionate hikers, playful youngsters or water lovers: Grächen offers numerous highlights for the whole family! Bathing fun, treasure hunts, llama trekking, a forest playground, a high-ropes course and much more to enjoy. In Grächen, you can take your pick between an idyllic natural lake, adventurous play parks or breathtaking hiking trails. And you'll get to relax at one of the numerous picnic and barbecue areas. What better place to try new things together? On your hikes, you will get to know the flora and fauna of the region.









Alpe Jungen: A ride on the small gondola, picturesque mountain panorama, idyllic mountain lake with picnic area, alpine flower meadows and local wildlife.

Kneipp gardens at lake Grächen and Taa: Soothing and refreshing, fun & play in the water.

Magic waters: Hikes along the Bineri, Drieri, Eggeri and Chilcheri Suonen.

Ravensburger games paths: A games passport and a games rucksack can be obtained from the Tourist Office Grächen after paying a deposit.

Treasure hunt: Water fun in the Suone, barbecue area on the Alpe Äbnet and many exciting adventures to finally conquer the treasure chest in the Tourist Office.

Robi's Forest Play Park: Slides, carousel, animals to pet, caves, climbing park, cool zip lines, mini golf course, George's crystal mine, and much more.

Best-Time

Outdoor enthusiasts who prefer to spend their holidays on two wheels will love Grächen as the perfect place to enjoy both exciting bike trails and leisurely paths. Enjoy spectacular rides through pine or larch forests and over vast alpine meadows! Or you cruise along dirt and gravel trails. No matter what bike experience you opt for: You will always be rewarded with a phenomenal view of the alps.



Tour tips

Flow trail: A five-kilometer downhill adventure for bike enthusiasts of all ages. Narrow gravel flow trails take you down to the valley.

Mattsand Enduro Trail: You skillfully maneuver over challenging, ever-changing terrain - often on narrow singletrails, some with exposure - and enjoy the incomparable view of the Riedgletscher, the Weisshorn and the

Matterhorn Valley Trail: Demanding in terms of fitness, this route leads from Zermatt past historic buildings in idyllic villages, along the Vispa and grants you a view of the vineyards. In St. Niklaus, you can take the turn-off to Grächen or keep following the route to Visp.

Grächen-Brig: This tour is demanding in terms of fitness and leads you to Stalden on the Mattsand Enduro Route as well as the Matterhorn Valley Trail. Take a breather and eniov the breathtaking views on the gondola to Gspon. The Gspon Panorama Bike trail takes you to Gibidum Pass and continues over a wide and steep gravel trail to Nanztal valley down to Brig.

Individual village tour: Embark on a wonderful journey through time. Find out more about historic buildings from the early modern period, what the famous barns are all about and why they are perched on four stilts with round stone slabs. Pick up your free 'Grächen village tour' brochure from the tourist office and follow the signs.

Hiking-Time

The hiking paradise Grächen offers the perfect hiking trail for all mountain enthusiasts. Easy or demanding hikes, interesting themed trails or maybe a mutli-day tour with an overnight stay at a traditional alpine hut? On every route, you will enjoy the view of the wonderful Valais mountainscape. With a bit of luck, you might also spot some local fauna.





Tour tips

High route Hannigalp–Saas Fee: Demanding day hike for sure-footed, experienced hikers along the mountain range through fragrant larch woods with views of the Bietschhorn, Fletschhorn, Lagginhorn, Weissmies and Balfrin.

From Hannigalp to Wannihorn: Fantastic panoramic view of the mountain range. With a bit of luck, you might spot ibex or chamois on this route.

Gross Bigerhorn: Experienced hikers will find their challenge along Europe's highest hiking trail.

Questioning round tour The lovingly designed themed trail leads you along numerous question marks where you can find answers to unusual questions about life with a twinkle in your eye.

Alpe Jungen Loop: An idyllic mountain lake, scenic views and interesting Alpine florg and fauna.
