Hop aboard the traditional little gondolas of the **St. Niklaus-Jungen cable car** and head straight up towards the sky. Alpe Jungen: the starting point for wonderful hikes such as the Alpine Flower Trail. Tip: Jungeralp mountain restaurant



The spectacular **Kalpetran-Embd-Schalb adventure trail** leads up to Alpe Schalb at 1,900 m above sea level – far from the crowds and an ideal starting point for a variety of hikes and the exciting Gogwärgijweg trail with its treasure hunt.
